

What is?

MANAGED OUTCOMES is a research project funded by the European Commission under the FP7-HEALTH Theme Work Programme 2009. The project started in January 2010 and its length is 36 months. It is made up by a European Consortium, with 10 partners.

Objectives

The main goal is to study the healthcare systems in Europe and its main parameters (structure of healthcare delivery, costs, efficiency, accessibility, quality of care, patient empowerment...). On the basis of all this information, the project will develop more effective and efficient healthcare systems models.

With the aim of reaching this, the methodology to follow will be divided in 2 steps:

1. Study Cases: Four types of pathologies are established, and different kind of information will be collected in six different European countries. This will allow us to assess how each of these pathologies is managed in each country of the study.
2. Scenarios: Using the information obtained in the cases of study, the healthcare system in these 6 countries will be described, reflecting the actual reality of the European healthcare systems.

For who?

The main goal is to inform the stakeholders about the relations and constrictions in the healthcare systems. Based on the operational and financial healthcare models, some recommendations will be given to provide regional, national and European-level decision-makers with a better understanding of healthcare service production systems.
