The project Mobile Inclusion Platform for Europe and Latin America (M-Inclusion) is a Support Action funded by the European Commission whose overall objective is to create a cooperation framework between EU and LATAM mobile solution developers and different entities (e.g., public bodies, Third Sector associations) related to the social inclusion.

Objectives

The main objective of the project is to strengthen the use and growth of affordable and innovating mobile solutions, oriented to the final user to promote the social integration of people in risk of exclusion. According to this, the following objectives have been defined:

- Develop an exhaustive inventory oriented to identify, on one hand, organizations and needs of the final users groups to study and, on the other hand, existing mobile solutions and trends for the social inclusion in the European Union and Latin America.
- Establish working groups who identify the main needs of the final users to study, who analyze technological solutions and trends related to mobile technologies and define a Roadmap.
- Support the identification and promotion of new ideas for future R+D projects.
- Generate market opportunities in the field of mobile technologies.
- Contribute to the discussion about the digital rift, sharing recommendations and conclusions with representatives of the Information and Communication Technologies industry and public entities with responsibility in the development of digital agendas at national and/or international level.
